Facility Plumber: 1st Shift

SUMMMARY:

The primary function of a Facility Plumber is to perform installation, repairs, improvements, and daily maintenance as necessary to the facility water, compressed air, and gas systems. This includes backflow preventers, boiler and hot water systems, fire pump, air compressors, and air dryers.

FUNCTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES:

- Works well independently as well as in a team environment.
- Maintains a clean and safe work area at all times.
- Comply with all GMP requirements, Company policies, procedures, and practices.
- Ability to install or replace domestic water heaters, chilled water pumps, and sump pumps.
- Able to read electrical schematics, mechanical drawings, and blue prints as well as following directions from manuals.
- Able to interpret work orders and complete them in a timely manner.
- Willing to make suggestions on improvements to plant systems as well as substitute replacement parts.
- Be proficient in the use of hand tools, power tools and manual repair equipment.
- Able to perform basic masonry and drywall repairs.
- Perform basic electrical and wiring troubleshooting, repairs and installations.
- Perform preventative maintenance and/or inspections on facility items such as eye wash stations, fire extinguishers, backflow preventers, heat exchangers, water heaters, chilled water systems, and bathrooms.
- Ability to install, test, and repair all sizes of backflow preventers.
- Ability to troubleshoot and repair steam, water, and gas distribution systems.
- Maintain and repair general plumbing components including but not limited to: toilets, urinals, faucets, hose bibs, water fountains, hand wash sinks, and drains.
- Ability to read and record written instructions.
- Notify Supervision of any issues.
- Must be trained in NFPA 70E for arc flash.
- Must have Lock Out/Tag Out Certification.
- Must have PIT (Power Industrial Truck) Certification
- All other duties as assigned.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

A Facility Plumber will be accountable to the Maintenance Supervisor for fulfillment of his or her duties. The performance of a Facility Plumber will be measured to the degree of his or her production levels and quality of work performed in these assigned areas.

EXPERIENCE:

Journeyman Plumbers License required with Backflow Preventer Certification preferred. 5 years of trades experience directly related to the duties and responsibilities specified. Must have basic electrical and mechanical skills as well as brazing, soldering, and welding skills. Ability to perform sanitary welding is preferred.

EDUCATION:

High School or equivalent. Backflow Preventer Certification is preferred.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

While performing the essential duties of this job, the employee must be able to stand, stoop, kneel, crouch and lift up to 50 lbs. and shared weight up to 100 lbs. Occasional exposure to airborne dust, high humidity and extremes of hot and cold are possible. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
